1. Can you introduce the university?

Established in 1956, the Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SHUTCM) was one of the first four TCM colleges across China. The 35-hectare campus of SHUTCM is located in the Research and Education Section, Zhangjiang Hi-Tech Park, Pudong New Area. From its founding, the SHUTCM has been home to numerous alumni: some of them are well-known physicians, some are distinguished researchers and some are working in community healthcare services. Thanks to the defining education feature of 'inheritance is the root and innovation is the soul', the University has achieved a great deal in both education and research over the recent years. Currently, the University offers doctorate degree programs in all TCM disciplines. 4. What are the requirements for admission?

Admission requirements for undergraduate programs : Foreign nationality, good health; High school graduation or higher education background; HSK $4 \ge 180$ (for majors taught in Chinese); TOFEL ≥ 90 or IELTS ≥ 6 (for majors taught in English).

Admission requirements for postgraduate programs: Foreign nationality, good health; A bachelor degree or degree of higher education background; TCM background or related professional background is required; HSK $5 \ge 180$ (for majors taught in Chinese); TOFEL ≥ 90 or IELTS ≥ 6.5 (for majors taught in English).

5. Is there any age limit for the course?

The age of undergraduate students should be between 16 and 45, and the age of master or doctoral students should be below 55. Exceptions can be considered for

applicants with competitive academic background or those recommended by collaborative universities.

6. Do I still need to take the Chinese courses of the first two years if I have attained HSK level 5?

Courses that recognized by school can be exempted.

7. I have taken some TCM courses in other schools. Do I need to take them again?

Courses that recognized by school can be exempted.

8. Can I major in both Chinese language and Traditional Chinese Medicine?

Yes. It is suggested that the students apply according to their own circumstances.

11. Is the dormitory provided? How much does it cost?

The applications documents mainly include high school diploma, scan of the passport, invoice of the application fee, language certificates (TOEFL or IELTS Certificate for English-taught Programs; HSK certificate for Chinese-taught Programs) and profile photo etc.

16. Is the application fee refundable?

The application fee is non-refundable once paid. Applicants (especially for graduate programs) are advised to consult the Admissions Office about eligibility and other admission requirements before paying the application fee and submitting their application.

Applicants will receive an "application Rejection" email from the Admissions Office within 2 weeks of submission if there are any problems with their application. If no email is received, the application has been completed and will enter the pre-admission process.
