

**Shanghai Government Scholarship for
International Students to Study Postgraduate Programs at Shanghai
University of Traditional Chinese Medicine**

1. Eligibility

- (1) Non-Chinese citizens, in good physical and mental health;
- (2) Have a postgraduate admission offered by the university in September 2020;
Applicants enrolled in a joint degree program are ineligible.
- (3) A bachelor's degree under the age of 40 for Master degree programs; and a master's degree under the age of 45 for PhD programs;
- (4) Non-recipients of Chinese Government Scholarships.

2. Coverage

Category A: Tuition fee is exempted, living stipend (Master Student 700RMB/month, Doctorate Student 1000RMB/month) is provided, on-campus accommodation and Comprehensive Medical Insurance for International students in China are exempted.

Category B: Tuition fee and Comprehensive Medical Insurance are exempt.

3. How to apply

- (1) Log into <http://study.edu.sh.gov.cn/> to complete the application online, and print out the form and sign.
- (2) Upload the signed application form onto the university website: <http://apply.shutcm.edu.cn/> by April 30th 2020. Choose the scholarship option "Shanghai Government Scholarship", and complete the application online.

4. Application documents

- (1) Signed application form for Shanghai Government Scholarship.
- (2) A Personal Statement up to 1000 words in Chinese (Chinese-taught program) or English (English-taught program).
- (3) Photocopies of highest diploma and graduate certificate attached with Chinese or English translations if in other languages.
- (4) Two recommendation letters.
- (5) A photocopy of passport.

(6) Physical Examination Form for Foreigners

5. Others

(1) Scholarship students shall go to the university to register on the date stipulated by the university. Students who have not received permission and arrive late for this process will have their scholarship automatically cancelled.

(2) Scholarship students MUST participate in annual scholarship evaluation. Scholarship recipients who fail to meet the requirements of the evaluation will have their scholarship cancelled.

(3) Scholarship students are not allowed to change their majors or study period.
