Preparatory Program on Chinese Language (Full-time) Year 2026

1. Program orientation:

This program targets at foreign students who are intending to join the bachelor program of Chinese Language or to comprehensively improve their Chinese Language proficiency.

2. Main courses and course features:

- ✓ Providing courses at beginner's, elementary, intermediate and advanced levels.
- ✓ Mixed classes of students from all countries, providing a conducive environment for multi-cultural interactions.
- ✓ Small classes with an average of 15 students.
- ✓ A streaming test is carried out at the beginning of the semester to facilitate students to choose a suitable starting point for learning.
- ✓ Connecting to the bachelor program of Chinese Language (TCM-oriented) with scholarship opportunities.

3. Program certificate:

Program certification will be awarded upon completion of all required courses and passing all examinations.

4. Type of class:

Independent

5. Application time:

- ✓ Deadline for Spring term: January 16th, 2026
- ✓ Deadline for Fall term: July 1st, 2026

6. Time of study:

- ✓ Spring term: March – July, 2026
- ✓ Fall term: September 2026 – July 2027 (Specific date will be informed in Registration Letter)

7. Eligibilities:

- ✓ 16 – 65 years old

- ✓ Good health condition with valid foreign passport
- ✓ High school qualifications and above
- ✓ To apply for the spring semester, the HSK score must be at least 180 points in Level 3.
To apply for the autumn semester, the HSK score must be at least 180 points in Level 2.

8. Fees:

- ✓ Application fees: 450 RMB per person
- ✓ Tuition fees: 9500 RMB per semester
- ✓ Accommodation:
 - (1) Refer to “International Student’s Dormitory ” (Attachment 1) (Current dormitory pricing, for reference only). Dormitories allocated upon admission will be arranged based on all student applications. Dormitory fees may fluctuate based on 2026 pricing regulations.
 - (2) Students may live off-campus upon approval by the University. All charges will be paid for by the student.

9. Application documents:

- ✓ Copy of the student’s passport (Passport info cannot be changed after the submission until the completion of enrollment, thus minimum 10 month’s validity is advised)
- ✓ High school graduation diploma or above and/or A-Level course transcript
- ✓ Payment invoice of application fee
- ✓ ID Photo:
 - File name and type: Chinese name, JPG file
 - Requirement: Bareheaded, 3.5*5.4cm, 626*413px resolution

Note: The photo will be used for your student ID card. Please ensure that the photo fulfills all above requirements. Usage of student ID may be compromised if requirements are not met.

10. Application details:

- ✓ All applications documents to be accurately completed and uploaded online according to requirements stated on the website. Application website: <https://apply.shutcm.edu.cn>
- ✓ Admission will be decided based on appraisal of submitted documents. Application fees will not be refunded as a result of the following circumstances: rejected applications due to incomplete documents, disqualified applications, students voluntarily withdraw.

- ✓ All accepted applicants are to bring along original copies of their application documents and proof of health (health screening results) for validation.

- ✓ Students may apply for the SHUTCM Scholarship for Chinese Language Students
- ✓ Students who have completed at least one semester of the Preparatory Program for TCM and continue with programs are eligible for applying for the International Student “Belt and Road” Scholarship ([Attachment 2](#)).
