Chinese Government Scholarship-Silk Road Program

This is a full scholarship for designated Chinese universities to recruit outstanding international students from countries along the "Belt and Road" for graduate studies in China. It only supports graduate students. Five applicants will be selected to receive this scholarship in SHUTCM.

I Supporting Categories, Duration and Instruction Language

1. Supporting Category: This scholarship only supports graduate students from countries along the "Belt and Road".

2. Duration: This scholarship only supports graduate students for no more than 3 academic years.

3. Instruction Language: Scholarship students can register for either Chinese-taught program or English-taught program.

II Scholarship Coverage

This program provides a full scholarship which covers tuition fee, accommodation (double room), stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance.

III How to Apply

IV Eligibility

1. Applicants must be a citizen from countries along the "Belt and Road", and in good physical and mental health;

2. The requirements for applicants' degree and age are that applicants must:

A bachelor's degree under the age of 35 for Master programs;

A master's degree under the age of 40 for PhD programs.

V Application Documents

1. Notarized highest diploma;

Prospective diploma recipients must submit official document issued by your current

school to prove your current student status or expected graduation date. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

2. Academic transcripts (written in Chinese or English);

Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

3. A Study Plan or Research Proposal (written in Chinese or English);800 words for postgraduate program applicants

4. Two Recommendation Letters (written in Chinese or English);

Applicants for undergraduate program and postgraduate program must submit two recommendation letters signed by professors or associate professors.

5. Foreigner Physical Examination Form (photocopy)

6. The copy of valid HSK Certificate for Chinese taught applicants and TOFEL or IELTS for English applicants(exempt for native Chinese or English speakers).

VI Others

Scholarship students MUST participate in annual scholarship evaluation. Scholarship recipients who fail to meet the requirements of the evaluation will have their scholarship cancelled.
